

SBYSA CODE OF CONDUCT PLEDGE

As a parent/guardian, I am aware that the Slate Belt Youth Soccer Association will conduct its soccer program with the highest regard for the player's safety and enjoyment. I agree that the Slate Belt Youth Soccer Association, its Board Members, Coaches, Referees, Volunteers and Playing Facilities are not responsible in any way for any unforeseen injuries that may occur while participating in SBYSA Soccer.

I UNDERSTAND, THAT WHILE SOCCER IS CONSIDERED A NON-CONTACT SPORT, BOTH CONTACT AND INJURIES HAVE AND WILL OCCUR.

I understand that SBYSA will assign my child to a team according to his/her age group.

I understand and acknowledge that I am responsible for the following:

- Transporting my child to and from practices and games
- Providing proper equipment for my child for this type of sports activity (shin guards, etc.)
- Supporting my child during all practices and games
- Conducting myself in a manner worthy of good sportsmanship, including the following:
 - Encourage sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and referees at all times
 - Refraining from the use of foul language or abusive language or gestures
 - Refraining from the use of alcohol or drugs prior to or during practices or games
 - Refraining from the use of any tobacco products during practices or games
 - Refraining from wearing shirts or other clothing depicting foul or abusive language or gestures or that promote alcohol, tobacco, drugs or violence
- Cooperating with the SBYSA Sports Association to facilitate and administer games and practices including the following:
 - No parent/guardian or spectator will be allowed on the playing fields unless the person is called upon
 - Responsible persons must have their player at games or practices at least 10 minutes before the required time and must arrive to pick up their player at least 10 minutes before the end of practice or game
- As a participant in the SBYSA soccer program, I agree to fully participate in all fundraisers or donations. I understand that failure to do so will result in my child not playing or participating
- Failure to adhere to the rules and regulations of this agreement will be brought before the SBYSA Board of Directors for review and will be handled according to its severity

I UNDERSTAND THE SYBSA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAN ANY PLAYERS, PARENT OR OTHER SPECTATOR FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT OR FOR RED CARD VIOLATIONS.
