

SBYSA PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT PLEDGE

As a parent/guardian, I am aware that the Slate Belt Youth Soccer Association will conduct its soccer program with the highest regard for my child's safety and enjoyment. I agree that the Slate Belt Youth Soccer Association, its board members, coaches, referees, volunteers, and playing facilities are not responsible in any way for any unforeseen injuries that may occur while my child is participating in SBYSA soccer.

I UNDERSTAND THAT WHILE SOCCER IS CONSIDERED A NON-CONTACT SPORT, BOTH CONTACT AND INJURIES HAVE AND WILL OCCUR.

I understand that SBYSA will assign my child to a team according to his/her age group.

I understand and acknowledge that I am responsible for the following:

- Transporting my child to and from practice
- Providing proper equipment for my child for this type of sports activity (i.e. shin guards)
- Supporting my child during all practices and games
- Conducting myself in a manner worthy of good sportsmanship, including the following:
 - * Encourage sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and referees
 - * Refraining from the use of foul or abusive language or gestures
 - * Refraining from the use of alcohol or drugs prior to or during practices or games
 - * Refraining from the use of tobacco products during practices or games
 - * Refraining from wearing shirts or other clothing that depict foul or abusive language or gestures or that promote alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or violence
 - * Complying with the SBYSA soccer rules
- Cooperating with the SBYSA Sports Association to facilitate and administer games and practices including the following:
 - * No parent/guardian or spectator will be allowed on the playing field unless the person is called onto the field
 - * Responsible persons must have their player at games or practices at least 10 minutes before the required time and must arrive to pick up their player at least 10 minutes before the end of practice or game
- As a participant in the SBYSA soccer program, I agree to fully participate in all fundraisers or donations. Failure to adhere to the rules and regulations of both this agreement and the SBYSA soccer rules will be brought before the SBYSA Board of Directors for review and will be handled according to its severity.

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I UNDERSTAND THAT THE SBYSA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAN ANY PLAYERS, PARENTS OR OTHER SPECTATOR FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT OR FOR SEVERE (RED CARD) VIOLATIONS OF THE SBYSA SOCCER RULES.

I also understand that NO pets of any kind are permitted on the practice or game fields and that failure to abide by this rule will result in your child not playing or participating.

The GOOD behavior and positive attitude of parents, guardians, relatives and other spectators is critical in assuring that your child gets the most from this soccer program. Remember that all of the SBYSA participants are volunteers - including yourself. Treat others as you wish to be treated. Know the rules. You will better enjoy the game.
